

General Order on Notice Requirements
Uniform Guardianship and Protective Proceedings Act
Probate Court of Mobile County, AL

The petitioner, through counsel, is responsible for perfecting notice/service on those parties entitled for any hearing set. **Fourteen (14) days** advanced notice is required except for notice by publication. Notice by Publication is perfected at least ten (10) days after the last run date of said publication notice.

Proofs of service must be filed with the clerk's office on or before the date of hearing.

For Adult (respondent/alleged) – serve the following parties:

1. The respondent by personal service, and
2. The spouse of the respondent, if any, and any adult children, or if none, parents
3. Any personal representative (guardian, etc.) or the custodian of the respondent
4. At least one adult relative in this State, if any, if no other person is served (2 or 3)

For Minor – serve the following parties:

1. The minor, if 14 years of age or older, and
2. Any person alleged to have had the principal care and custody of the minor during the 60 days preceding the filing of the petition; and
3. The parents of the minor; if none, the minor's nearest relative in this State, and
4. Any guardian or conservator over the minor

Note: except for the adult respondent/alleged, other parties may be served personally or by certified mail, with return receipt signed

DOCTOR - If the respondent is an adult, or as may be required for a minor for reasons other than minority, the petitioner, through counsel, shall have the said party examined by a medical doctor or psychologist (Ph.D.) and obtain a written report which must contain the following information:

- a) The date of examination
- b) The conclusions reach by the doctor
- c) An opinion as to the need for a guardian and/or conservator
- d) Such other information as the doctor may wish to submit

Counsel for the petitioner must ensure that the examining doctor is aware of this general order of the Court and of the specific information to be in his/her written report.
